The 12th Austrian Stable Isotope User Group Meeting is jointly organized by the Institute of Applied Geosciences (Graz University of Technology), the Institute of Earth Sciences (Graz University) and RESOURCES - Institute for Water, Energy and Sustainability (Joanneum Research).

Stable isotope analyses provide exciting new approaches in a variety of current research topics ranging from Earth and Biological to Forensic and Medical Sciences. This meeting aims to bring together researchers and students in an informal workshop-like atmosphere to improve communication and interaction within and across disciplines and institutions. The meeting will include invited and contributed talks, as well as poster presentations.

Regular oral presentation will be a 20-minutes talk (including 5 min discussion). Posters are welcome and each poster will be presented by a 3 min "speed" presentation in front of the poster. Abstracts of all presentations (oral and posters) should be sent by e-mail as attachment (word format) to: abstract@sina2013.info and should include title, authors, affiliation and abstract (maximum 350 words). It is possible to include small illustrations. Abstracts will be provided by the organizers as download on this website and in print form at the meeting.
